

ARTICLE FORMAT

The text will be structured in the following order: TITLE, AUTHORS, KEY-WORDS, ABSTRACT (max. 300 words), INTRODUCTION, METHODOLOGY, RESULTS, DISCUSSION (or RESULTS AND DISCUSSION), CONCLUSIONS, ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS (if necessary) and REFERENCES

Page Format: A4, with margins - left-2,5 cm; right-2,5 cm; head-2,5 cm; foot-2,5 cm;
Characters: Times New Roman, Line Spacing - Single

Paper title: capital letters, Font Size 11, Bold

- Spacing: 1 line -

Last name and first name of the authors (capital letters, Font Size 11), position, affiliation, full address of the institution

- Spacing: 1 line -

Key words: Font Size 10

- Spacing: 1 line -

Title and text of the abstract: Font Size 10 (in an international language other than that of the text)

- Spacing: 2 lines -

Text of the paper: Times New Roman, Font Size 11

References: centred, capital letters, Font Size 10, Bold

- Spacing: 2 lines -

Figures: will be introduced in the text but in the JPG-format as well. Titles and the legend will be translated into the language the paper is written in.

Reference titles: References should appear at the end of the paper. The word REFERENCES has to be written in Times New Roman 10 points. The title of the book/article must be written in italic characters and the rest of the information with normal characters. Ladies: name in full; Men: family name in full & first letter of first name.
